



## Call for Nominations for the Board of Directors

Tourism Squamish works collaboratively with partners and leverages its resources to execute strategic marketing, sales and customer service programs that deliver both more and higher yield visitors to Squamish throughout the year. We provide industry leadership locally and we create awareness within our community of the value of tourism and the products and services that we offer to our visitors.

**Number of positions available:** There are (6) positions available for a two (2) year term.

Two (2) director positions representing the 2% MRDT collectors within the District of Squamish two (2) of which must be representing properties with 50 rooms or more

### AND

Four (4) directors representing a tourism related business or having relevant experience in the activity, attraction, retail, restaurant, guiding or educational sectors.

If more than six nominations are received, an election will be held via ballot at the AGM scheduled for May 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2017 at 4:00pm.

If only six (6) nominations are received, the nominees will be elected by acclamation.

**All completed nomination forms must be returned to the Tourism Squamish office by 4:00pm Thursday, May 18, 2017.**

Each nomination MUST include a brief biography of the nominee that includes relevant experience and how that experience will benefit Tourism Squamish and the local tourism community. Submissions must be suitable for distribution to the Tourism Squamish membership.

### Board of Director Responsibilities

Directors work together to govern Tourism Squamish through the development, approval and evaluation of policy. Directors are bound by the Code of Conduct and Terms of Reference.

**Time Commitment:** Directors are required to attend eight regular scheduled Board meetings plus the Annual General Meeting within a 12-month period. Directors are also requested to attend a full day strategic planning session in the Fall in addition to representing Tourism Squamish at various community events and meetings. Directors may from time to time be asked to participate on committees and task forces outside of the regular scheduled meetings.
